

Elva 55th Reunion for 2010 ELVF VSCDA Road America

Elva Specific Itinerary and Schedule

The following Schedule is Elva Specific including street Elvas and display cars that will not be racing, Racers attending this weekend will need to review the VSCDA Schedule for the latest revisions, for their class which can be located at www.raceelfv.org and <http://www.vscda.org/>

IMPORTANT: Please pre-register at the Elva Website in order that we can anticipate attendance at this event www.elva.com

I. Elva Race Cars Racing General Information:

1. VSCDA registration is required for early sign up and discount (before August 20, 2010) at <http://www.vscda.org/> make sure to include the Elva Banquet in your registration (\$30 adult).
2. It is intended that we collect Elva race cars so that they are located near to each other on the flat area at the lower level paddock near Turn 5.
3. This special weekend allows an abundance of racing for a standard race fee. We anticipate that most Elvas will be entering the Feature Race for their class, plus the All Elva Race and the individual Cup Races relating to your car classification. This could mean 3 races on Sunday, and if you are interested you can also race in the Friday Enduro for an additional cost of \$75.
4. All Elva Car Show Friday Night we will try to line up race cars that are not participating in the Enduro as early as 4 pm (see details below)
5. Please also pre-register on the Elva Website at www.elva.com so we can anticipate your participation.

II. Elva Street Cars and Race Cars Not Racing General Information Overview:

- 1) Registration with VSCDA registration is required if you want to bring your trailer and show car into the paddock. Location will be outside exit to Turn 5, which is also a great viewing area; Map at <http://www.roadamerica.com/userfiles/file/2010%20Maps/Competitor%20Map%202010.pdf>
- 2) Friday night car show is free. Start setting up street cars at 4pm in front of the Road America Welcome Center / Tech Barn (see details below)
- 3) Saturday Elkhart Lake Street Course Re-Enactment (see details below)
- 4) Saturday John Fitch & Burdette Martin Elva Banquet tickets are limited and you are encourage to contact VSCDA website for advance purchases (\$30 Adult) at <http://www.vscda.org/>
- 5) Sunday All Elva Race Parade Lap
Register 9am Sunday at the Elva Tent if you would like to participate in the one lap (parade lap) at the start of the all Elva Feature Race. There is a charity donation of \$40.00. You will be in the front of the racing Elvas with a pace car

that will pull off after one lap allowing race cars to start the race after 2 laps. You should be prepared to safely travel the one lap at speeds up to 70 MPH with a tight formation so not to interfere with the race when we exit the track.

III. Itinerary and Schedule for Elva Street Cars and Race Cars Not Racing:

FRIDAY September 10:

4 pm – Start assembling rows per class for an all Elva Car Show located in front of the Tech Building open field. Please see signs for your designated row which will include:

- A. Front Engine Sports Racers
- B. Formula Juniors
- C. Rear Engine Sports Racers
- D. Bexhill and Hastings built Couriers (Mk.I & II)
- E. Trojan-Elva built Couriers (Mk.III & IV)
- F. McLaren-Elva

6pm – Popular vote ballots collected for most popular street car and race car

7pm – Trophy presented to most popular Race Car and Street Car

A photo shoot will be taken between these times.

SATURDAY September 11:

3pm –Elkhart Lake Road Course Re-enactment - Police escort racecars and streetcars on the original public roads that the first races were run on. This is open to the public. These roads are listed as a national historic monument. Along with Watkins Glen these are the only two sets of roads to be listed as such. This re-enactment tour has been held over the past nineteen years and it attracted over one hundred fifty cars in 2007. The cars finish the tour and are parked on part of the original street course in the heart of the Village of Elkhart Lake. This event has been thoroughly enjoyed by the participants and the spectators.

10am - 1:00pm staging – The “Gathering on the Green” Concours at Osthoff Resort, which borders the original road course and overlooks Elkhart Lake. This event is held on the grounds of the Osthoff, being a classic car display. Over 50 cars graced the field in 2008. Music by Swingtime Band, cocktails, conversation and classics was enjoyed by all. The show begins in the late afternoon and ends when the banquet starts. This is by invitation only for a select group of cars. If you would like to display one of your cars please contact us with your interest. This is rapidly becoming a must do event

6pm – Osthoff Resort Banquet prelude with Elva DVD and photos from past Elvas at Elkhart Lake / Road America Days.

7:15 pm - Banquet –Speaker John Fitch one of America’s most important Sports Car Legends who raced professionally for Cunningham, Mercedes and many others in the 50s & 60s. Elva Speaker Burdette Martin will share the podium with Mr. Fitch and will share

his Elva experiences from that era and racing alongside Carl Haas and many others in the early Elva Sports Racers at Road America.
